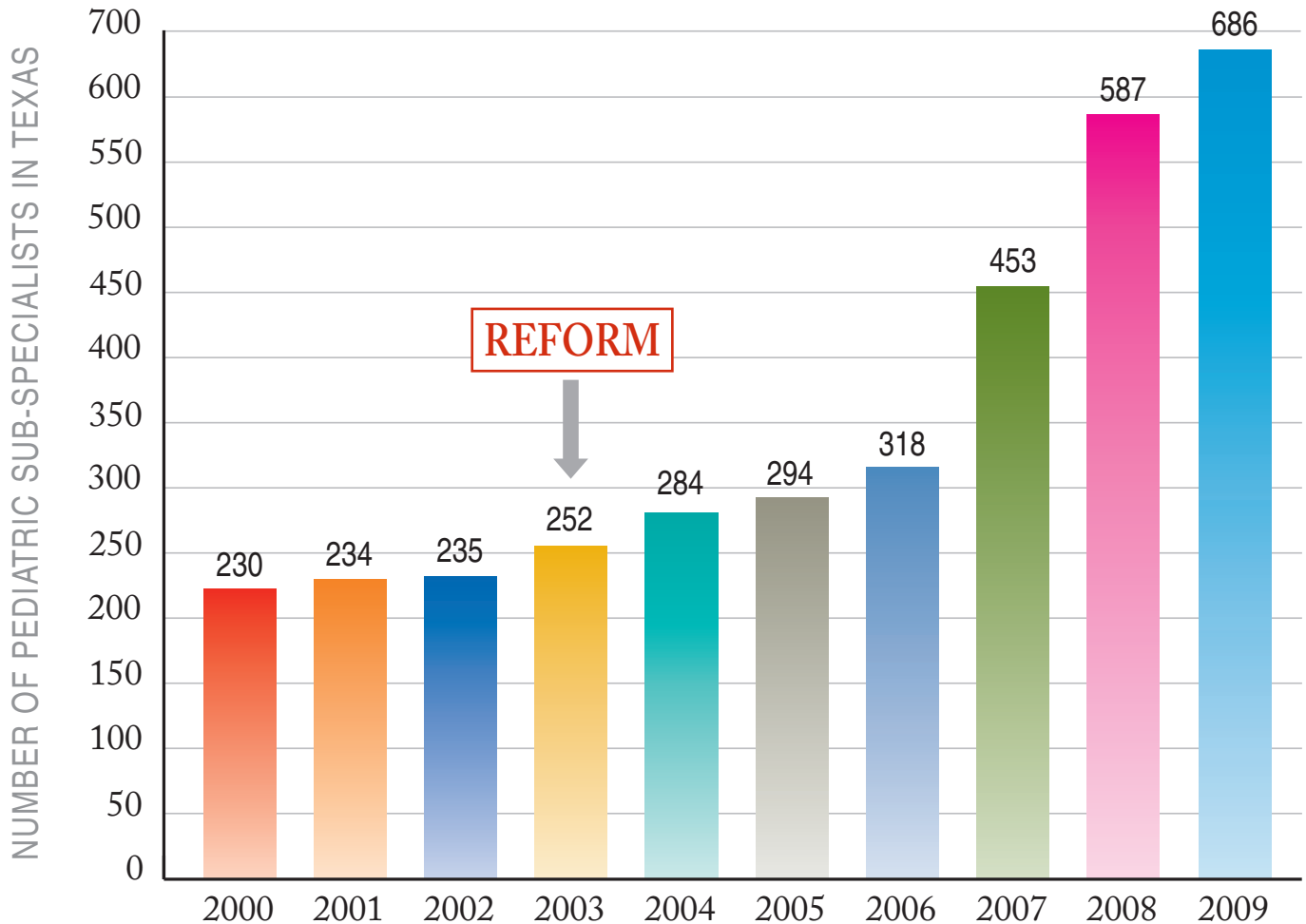


PEDIATRIC SUB-SPECIALISTS IN TEXAS (2000 - 2009)
