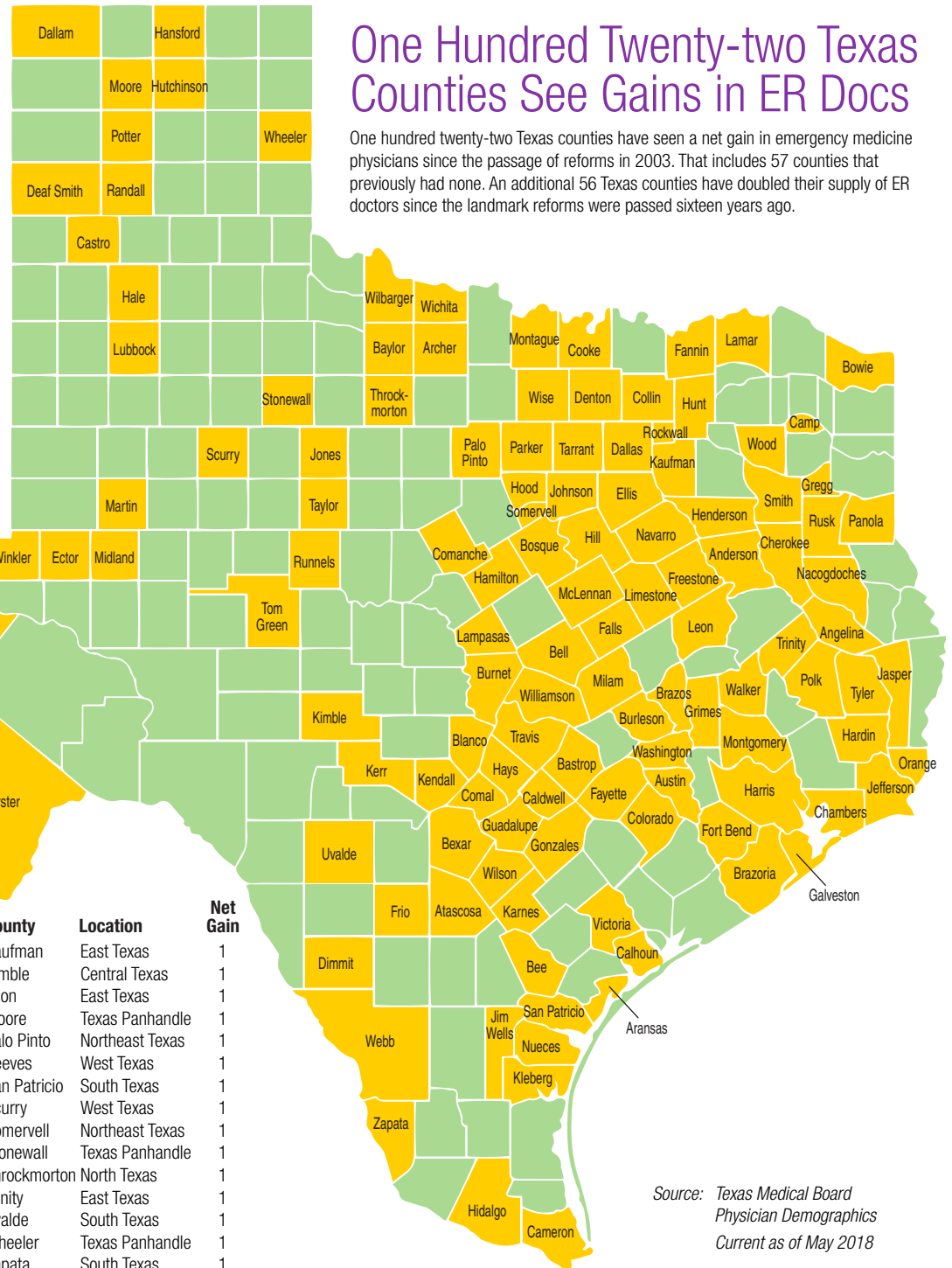

An additional 56 Texas counties have doubled their supply of ER doctors since the landmark reforms were passed sixteen years ago.
